Mistake 1: Not meeting customers

“what the customer buys is seldom what the company sells” Peter Drucker



Normal times: meet, observe
Covid-times: Talk - Zoom, Skype, Phone!!!!

Customers - Users - Stakeholders

Statistics can't tell you intention or need

- How do you know what they need?
- How do you know what they value?
- How do you know when you are wrong?

Authority flows from speaking with
customers

Mistake 2: Not putting value on stories

As a Financial Advisor
I want to see projected fund value
So I can demonstrate the effect of
savings to clients

Effort: 10 points

Value: 100 business points

Put value estimates on
stories before effort
estimates

Value changes effort



Mistake #3: Planning by effort estimate

Your effort estimates are **WRONG**

- Planning with effort estimates is flawed from the start



Plan first with value

- Appreciate how value changes over time
- Plan backwards

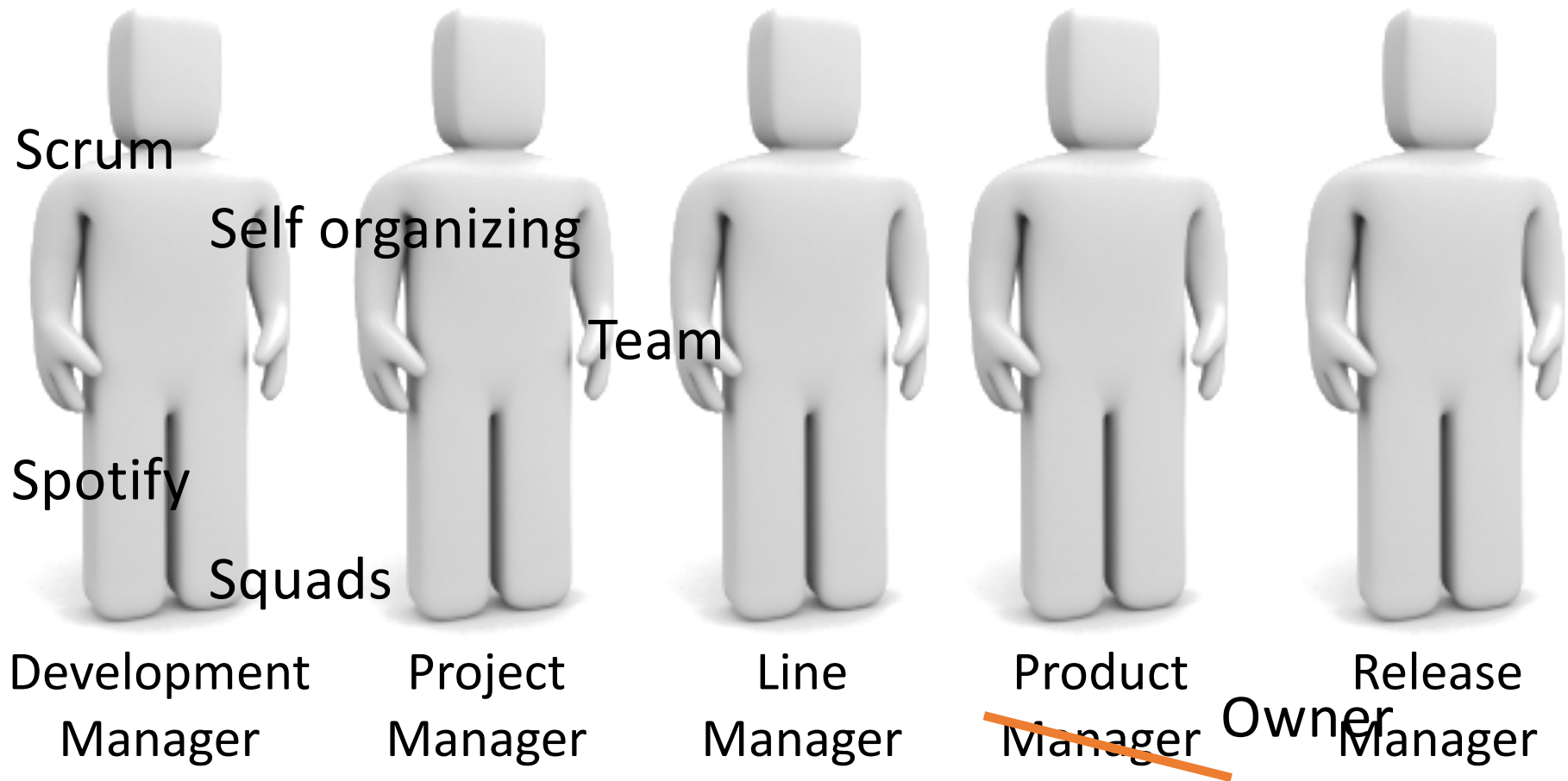


A little bit sooner

PO is not the last manager standing

Product Owner is not:

- Project Manager
- Development Manager
- Line Manager
- Delivery Manager

(They might be a Product Manager)



Product Owner is:

- Specialist in what customer needs
- How to increase value
- Short of time

Authority comes from specialism & knowing customers

Mistake 5: Developers acting up

Just because you are good at coding doesn't mean you are good at understanding what customers want

Product Owners

- Empathise with customers
- Feel their pain
- Skilled at talking to customer
- Analysis oriented



Developers

- Empathise with technology
- Feel the code
- Skilled at talking to machines
- Synthesis oriented



I could go on...

- Owners don't report to Managers; Managers report to Owners
- Product Owners who code
- Fear of coding: doing is faster than talking
- Not spending time with the team
- Doing too much
